SCENE THREE

VERONICA crosses as lights come up on her backyard. Simple suburban, perhaps the lower end of the middle class spectrum. There's a little garden table where VERONICA's MOM and DAD sit. MOM applies spread to a snack cracker. DAD reads a spy novel.

The three HEATHERS and VERONICA play croquet.

HEATHER CHANDLER

START

God, Veronica, drool much?

The other HEATHERS laugh.

You left a puddle slobbering over that new kid.

More laughter.

VERONICA

C'mon, I don't even know his name—

HEATHER CHANDLER hits VERONICA's ball off the field in the direction of VERONICA's MOM and DAD.

Mom, Dad! Look out!

MOM picks up the ball. HEATHER CHANDLER crosses to retrieve it.

MOM

Here you go, girls. Care for some pâté?

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HEATHER CHANDLER inspects the cracker, suspicious.

HEATHER CHANDLER

This isn't pâté. It's liverwurst.

MOM

(polite) I'm aware of that, Heather. It's a family joke.

HEATHER CHANDLER

Oh. Funny.

VERONICA hurries over for damage control. HEATHER CHANDLER puts the cracker to her lips for a micro-bite.

DAD looks up, speaking out loud for the first time.

DAD

Doggone it, will somebody please tell me why I read these spy novels?

VERONICA answers by rote. It's a long-standing family "bit."

VERONICA

Cuz you're an idiot, Dad.

DAD smiles, giving the expected response:

DAD

Oh yeah, that's it.

...and back to the book. VERONICA is now acutely aware of HEATHER CHANDLER's judgemental smirk.

MOM

You two. So girls. Any plans for tonight?

VERONICA

Big homecoming party at Ram Sweeney's house. I'm catching a ride with Heather.

HEATHER CHANDLER taps her Swatch.

HEATHER CHANDLER

Speaking of which...

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VERONICA

Right. Great pâté, Mom, but we have to motor if we want to be ready for that party.

HEATHER CHANDLER plops the croquet ball into the "pâté"...

HEATHER CHANDLER

Oops.

...and walks away.

The other two HEATHERS follow because that's what they do.

VERONICA cringes, embarrassed by her friend's bad behavior. MOM takes her arm.

MOM

Don't let these popular girls change you.

VERONICA

I need them.

MOM

For what? You have other friends. You have Martha.

VERONICA

Maybe I want more out of life than liverwurst.

VERONICA pulls her arm free and walks away. DAD speaks without looking up from his book.

DAD

Those girls seem really nice.
